1. Applicant must have a 3.0 grade average or above.
2. Applicant must be a female senior and accepted by a four-year college.
3. Applicant may not be a daughter of a BPW member.
4. Applicant must complete this application (application does not have to be typed).
5. Applicant must submit a copy of her 202 - 2026 FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI).
6. Applicant will request from her school counselor a letter of recommendation stating that she meets the scholarship requirements, has financial need, possesses leadership qualities, and has attainable goals.
7. Applicant will have her school counselor send her transcript AND letter of recommendation via mail to:
